The PtD Competency Framework and **Building Human Resources for Supply Chain** Management Theory of Change are adopted in the Ethiopian Pharmaceuticals Supply Agency's human resources strategy. (2020)

The Human Resources for Supply Chain Management Rapid Diagnostic leads to Thailand's Ministry of Health acknowledging the importance of health supply chain professionals, paving the way for the inclusion of supply chain management in the country's strategies and policies. (2020)

Guidance from PtD, in collaboration with USAID's GHSC-PSM project, leads Rwanda's Ministry of Health to revise its job descriptions for supply chain staff.
